- Entry Fees: \$15 per athlete. All entry fees must be paid on-line at www.coacho.com by using a credit card by midnight on June 10, 2010.
- Club Entries: A club representative must register athletes on-line at www.coacho.com by **midnight on Thursday, June 10**. Unattached athletes must also register at this site. Current AAU numbers and hometown must be entered.
- Age Divisions: Primary-2002 or Later; Sub Bantam-2001; Bantam-2000; Sub Midget-1999; Midget-1998. Determined by age of athletes on December 31, 2010.
- Number of Events: Age groups Primary through Midget - 3 events
- Relay events are counted as one of the limiting events.
 - Athletes may only enter those events listed for their age division as indicated by their year of birth.
- Relay Teams: Only currently registered Ozark AAU Clubs may field a relay team.
- Awards: 1st through 3rd place- medals /4th through 6th place- ribbons
- Concessions: There will be a full service concession stand open during the meet.

- National Qualifier Meets: Athletes from all divisions who receive a fair mark in any event will qualify for the AAU National Qualifier meets. Dates and locations can be obtained on www.coacho.com. Area 11 National Qualifier meets will be held June 24-27 in Tulsa, Oklahoma or July 1-4 in Joplin, Missouri. Registration is through www.coacho.com Athletes can participate in any National Qualifier Meet, however, athletes can only participate in only one National Qualifier Meet.
- This event is sanctioned by the Amateur Athletic Union of the U. S., Inc.
 - All participants must have a current AAU membership.
 - AAU membership may not be included as part of the entry fee to the event.
 - AAU membership must be obtained before the competition begins except where the event operator has a laptop available with an internet connect. Participants are encouraged to visit the AAU web site www.aausports.org to obtain their membership.

There will be no entries permitted after the posted deadline date of June 10th by midnight.

All field events will have 4 attempts. There will be no finals. High jump is excluded from this rule.

All events except the 100 meter dash are finals.
